Classroom Community

The Montessori Program consists of students in grades 1 to 6. Students are in mixed-aged groups, typically three-year cycles, which helps children to solidify their learning. This also develops leadership, collaboration skills, and positive relationships.

Individualized Learning and Teacher-as-Guide

Montessori teachers observe each child, working as a guide to introduce children to the range of materials they need at just the right time. Montessori teachers hold a British Columbia teaching certificate and additional Montessori certification.

Independence and Self-Guided Learning

Students are encouraged to direct their learning, creating intrinsic motivation as they explore areas of interest at a deeper level. This approach also builds accountability as they plan and prioritize their daily learning tasks.

Natural, Specialized Montessori Materials
