Expect to graduate with skills in plant identification, landscape maintenance techniques, integrated pest management, proper pruning techniques, basic irrigation hydraulics and maintenance of landscape equipment.

After graduation, you'll have a certificate in horticulture. You can go to work or continue your studies by applying your credits to a diploma in horticulture management.

PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

Immersive learning environment

Students have access to more than 250 hectares of land on the TRU Kamloops campus, providing endless opportunities to participate in industry relevant projects that develop skills and knowledge. Our immersive outdoor classroom consists of naturalized and cultivated landscapes, horticulture gardens, greenhouses and an orchard. This type of learning environment prepares students for employment in the horticulture industry.

Practicum placement

As part of the transition from education to employment, students participate in a three-week practicum at a placement of their choosing. This practicum allows students to solidify information learned at TRU, see its application in the workplace and participate in the day-to-day operations of a business. Students get the chance to explore different directions they may wish to pursue within the horticulture industry. Often, these practicum placements lead to employment.
